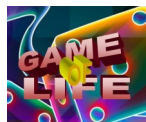

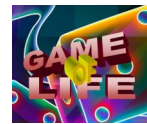

Some of the topics we will be teaching on:

- 1.) **Qualities of Friendships**-Kindness, loyalty, bullying, how to gain and keep friends, think before you speak, stalking, lying
- 2.) **You only get one chance to make a first impression**-Communication, body language, facial expressions, your moods and how they effect others
- 3.) **Dealing with rejection-Hurt feelings**—yours and others
- 4.) **Click, Like, Share**—Facebook, Texting, Phone, email, Internet, scams
- 5.) **Staying safe in the community**-stranger awareness, body language and how to deal with authorities if you encounter them
