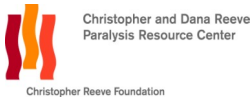

Tonight we will teach the participants, how to prep a meal, set a table, wait on people, clean up on and help raise a little money for the SNR Life Program.

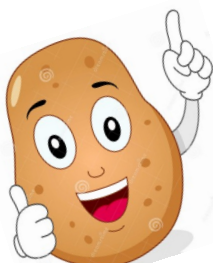
